## **DRIVEMYCAR SIGNS EXCLUSIVE AGREEMENT WITH TRIVETT FOR BMW, JAGUAR, MINI AND LAND ROVER VEHICLES**

Collaborate Corporation Limited (ASX:CL8) is pleased to announce that its DriveMyCar business unit has signed an agreement with Trivett Automotive Group Pty Ltd to promote and rent BMW, Jaguar, Mini and Land Rover vehicles to private and corporate customers. Trivett is one of Australia's largest prestige automotive groups and the retail unit of Inchcape Australia.

As part of the relationship with DriveMyCar, Trivett is providing the opportunity to rent various models from the BMW, Mini, Jaguar and Land Rover brands in Sydney & Melbourne, providing many people with the opportunity to experience a range of models from these prestige brands, which are rarely available for rent through traditional car rental companies.

This material agreement with Trivett Group, which will initially deliver twenty vehicles, is the second deal with an Inchcape company, following the 12 October announcement of the agreement with Subaru. This agreement is expected to deliver a strong increase in the number of vehicles available for rental and will add new vehicles from prestige brands to the fleet. The expansion of vehicles is expected to provide further strong contribution to the revenue growth of the DriveMyCar business.

Models included in the rental programme include various 1, 2, 3 and 4 series BMWs, plus X series models; the Jaguar F-Pace and XE, Mini and the Land Rover Evoque and Discovery Sport. DriveMyCar has appointed Trivett as its exclusive automotive dealer supplier for new or near new models from these brands in the Sydney & Melbourne region. DriveMyCar will support a number of use cases including extended test drives, service loan vehicles, holiday rentals and corporate rentals.

Trivett Managing Director, Peter Mullan, said "This venture offers customers a wonderful entree into a wide variety of prestige models. For discerning drivers that want to be certain they are making the right choice, it's a fantastic way to 'live' with a vehicle for a little while and ensure it meets their needs. It's in line with our innovative customer-centric philosophy, aimed at delivering premium service at every touchpoint."
